The painting and storm window project are to begin in September.


CHURCH DIRECTORY UPDATE

SUPPORT COMMITTEE-GIVING WITH GRACE

Our "Last Will and Testament" is a document that we leave behind to instruct our heirs as to how we would like to divide our life's wealth. How you divide your accumulated wealth should be your decision, but for many of us it is a hard document to produce because it requires us to deal with our own mortality. We must face the certainty that we will not live forever.

The uglier truth is that if we do not create a **Last Will** of our choosing, our assets will be divided by convoluted regulations established by New Jersey under the control of court-appointed administrators. In other words, if you do not create a **Will**, the State has created one for you. Under State mandate, not only will money and property be shared by our heirs, but the court will determine who will have control over minor children. Children regardless of their level of maturity can gain full control of an inheritance when they reach the age of 18.

A court appointed administrator can never know our heirs as we do. A court appointed administrator can never know our heartfelt desires for those we leave behind. Moreover, there are no provisions in court-administered estates to provide for contributions to charity. Unless you create a **Will**, no charities of your choice can benefit from your life's work. Have you considered naming Grace Lutheran Church, or any other charity for that matter, to be included in your Will? Without a **Will**, charitable contributions from your estate are impossible.

It is always good advice when considering any gift transaction to consult your tax advisor as to how that gifting strategy might affect your personal situation.

CALL COMMITTEE (REPORTED BY STEPHEN GRING, CHAIR)

Grace Council has appointed a Call Committee to oversee the process of selecting the next pastor. The main purpose of the Call Committee is to interview prospective applicants for the position of pastor and recommend a candidate to Council.

Members of the Call Committee include: Stephen Gring, Chair; Chris Dennis, Secretary; Wendy Dolan; Meg Markkanen; Carol Landes; and Eddie Thompson.

The first task of the Call Committee was to complete the MSP- the Ministerial Site Profile, an 11 page document that includes information related to the demographics of the Church, goals and aspirations of the congregation, expectations for the new pastor and other pertinent information.

The MSP was filed with the Synod in early July after it was reviewed and edited by Council.

The next step in the process is a meeting of Council and Call Committee with the Bishop; this meeting has been scheduled for mid -September . Following this requisite meeting, the Bishop will officially activate the search process and solicit applicants.

Given this very methodical process established by the Synod, it is very realistic to surmise that the appointment of a new pastor could take months.
