A Note from the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Friends in Christ,

Thanksgiving is such a fascinating time of year. Outside the trees are going bare and the darkness comes earlier, but into this season we choose to celebrate harvests of what really matters. Family and friends gather, recipes old and new are brought out, we find time in our impossibly busy lives to set a table and give thanks.

Like most years, at this time people want to be generous. It's beautiful to see. I think that over the year, people strive to be generous, but in November we get to see it happen so much and so often that we can open up to goodness in ways we don't during, say, spring or summer. Especially in these days with questions about broader safety nets, we are seeing local people stop in and ask how they can help.

Being in the Church office, and hearing from Corinne, we are seeing two simultaneous peaks: a surge in numbers of people asking for help, with a rise in numbers of people bringing donations. People are coming in off of the street to drop off gift cards and carts of food. Volunteers are working together to prepare the shelves and to care for people in need. Congregations are making special collections. It's not a one-to-one ratio, but each contribution makes a difference. People are coming to Grace so that a table can be set for Thanksgiving.

<u>This is what it can mean to be Church</u>: to open a door for the needy to come in, be treated with care, and sent out with at least some needs met. Church is a place where people can help others know: If I enter here, I will be part of doing good. At Church, the hunger to help meets hunger for support. We are brought together and we are all changed.

I pray that in this season of Thanksgiving you will experience many reasons to give thanks: Those who can give will find joy in giving; those who receive will be blessed by their time here and the food they carry out; and all who seek hope will see that in being brought together we can say to the Giver of all Good Gifts, "Thank you!"

Grace Place Food Pantry continues to provide food to our neighbors in need who live in the communities of Northfield, Linwood and Somers Point!

We are now preparing for our Holiday Basket distributions (Thanksgiving and Christmas), which is going to be a large undertaking this year. 2025 has been challenging, to say the least. Each month we continue to see a large increase in people dealing with food insecurity. We receive a monthly delivery from the Community Food Bank located in Egg Harbor Township but they have seen big changes in what they receive and that trickles down! I submit a monthly wish list but not all requested items are received. We shop weekly in order to supplement what we receive from the Food Bank so that we can continue to offer a variety of food items.

Grace Place is extremely fortunate in that we receive so much support by way of cash donations or food items from area churches, businesses, various organizations and generous individuals! Through the month of October, once a week, we had one individual shop at Santori's for fresh fruits and vegetables! You can imagine how well received that was! We have regular friends of Grace Place who stop in on a weekly basis to contribute bread, eggs, butter and anything else they happen to feel our neighbors would enjoy.

Just a reminder - our local ShopRite and Acme stores offer a free turkey should you spend a certain amount of money. If you do qualify for a turkey but are not planning to use it, please consider donating it to *Grace Place*. We would be very appreciative!

In closing, we are very grateful to Grace Lutheran Church (and its congregation) for housing this pantry for over thirty years. Everyone helps in so many ways and we are truly blessed!
